- Open day care is a meeting place for children and adults.
- It's an activity centre for children, a place to play and get to know other children.
- Open day care is for children up to six years of age who are accompanied by an adult.
- You don't need to sign up.
- You can come and go as you please.
- A few private programmes require payment.

- It's a great opportunity to get to know other children and adults in your neighbourhood.
- You can get support and guidance in your role as a parent.
- You can obtain more information about various public local services for families with young children.

What can we do together?

- Paint and draw.
- Free play activities.
- Eat a meal together.
- Sing.

- In open day-care all the adults take part in the play and activities.
- Everyone contributes to creating an open and inclusive environment for young and old, large and small.
- Everyone helps with the practical chores.
